



GUIDELINES FOR ORDERING CURRICULUM

Kelowna Christian Open School offers educational credits to families enrolled in our e-campus program. The primary use of these credits is to ensure that your child(ren) are provided with the core curriculum needed to complete each grade level.

An important consideration when ordering curriculum is each child's individual learning style. Together, families and contact teachers review curriculum choices before orders are placed. Completing the on-line learning style profile prior to ordering is recommended.

The following is a brief summary of curriculum guidelines.

- Educational credits are approved for a wide range of curriculum, lessons, rentals, and services. Extraordinary requests are considered on an individual basis.
- Core curriculum resources are the first priority when using educational credits.
- Curriculum, equipment, activities, rentals, lessons and services must meet the objectives of the Student Learning Plan.
- Approved items include: appropriate student textbooks, workbooks, literature and instruction-related print materials; full curriculums or complete courses; educational software with direct relationship to skill development, including Edhelper, What in the World, United Streaming; rental of sports equipment; music and sports lessons.
